Modern Piano Music Celebration



For the first time in WMTA history, a festival celebrating Twentieth Century Music was held on June 11, 2016, at the Chevy Chase United Methodist Church, 7001 Connecticut Avenue, NW in Chevy Chase MD. MPM featured both competitive and non-competitive sections. All entrants received critiques and certificates. Winners in the competitive division received cash prizes and ribbons. Sixteen students from six studios entered.

Adjudicator was Bradford Gowen, a member of the faculties of the University of Maryland and the Washington Music Conservatory. Beside writing comments and assigning honors, he gave a mini master class at the end of each group.

The repertoire featured a wide range of styles and composers from all over the world: X. Montsalvatge (Spain), Alberto Ginastera (Argentina), Carl Vine (Australia), Mutsuo Shishido (Japan), Paul Creston, Greg Presley, William Bolcom, Ned Rorem, Robert Muczynski (US), Tan Dun (China), Fazil Say (Turkey), Howard Ferguson (UK), Li-ly Chang (Taiwan/US).
