This is a non-competitive event. Performers will receive a critique and a certificate of participation.

Eligibility: Open to instrumental and voice students through the 12th grade.
Repertoire: Solo or ensemble music written by a composer of the Baroque period whose birth and death dates fall between 1650 and 1760. See the Special Rules section for limitations on permitted arrangements or transcriptions. Consult with the Chair in advance if there are any questions about repertoire.
Time Limits: Performers may play one or two pieces, with a maximum time limit of 8 minutes per performer. A Prelude and Fugue will be considered as two pieces.

Special Rules:

- Pianists may not program simplified arrangements. No method book pieces are allowed.
- Performers needing an accompanist must provide their own.
- Bowed string, wind, and brass instrument arrangements and transcriptions are permitted at the elementary level only. Guitar arrangements and transcriptions are permitted at all levels
- This event is memory optional for all performers.
- All participants are responsible for complying with U.S. copyright law. For use of copied or downloaded materials, please refer to the WMTA General Rules.
