- 1. Baroque: Works from the Baroque period or transcriptions. For example: a Bach Prelude and Fugue; two Sonatas by Scarlatti or Soler; a Bach-Busoni transcription; three movements of a Suite.
- 2. Classical: A movement of a Sonata by Haydn, Clementi, Beethoven, Mozart or early Schubert.
- 3. Romantic: Any major composition.
- 4. Impressionistic/Contemporary: An Impressionistic period piece or a piece written in the 20th or 21st century.

All repertoire selections must be approved by the Chair before the deadline. Consult with the Chair in advance if you have any questions.
